

Northern Border Pipeline Company (Northern Border) has received gas that does not conform to its gas quality standards. Effective November 17, 2017 Northern Border is issuing an OFO watch for the following receipt points that may be delivering gas that does not conform to the gas quality standards specified in Northern Border Tariff Section 6.5 - paragraph 1(a):

The issuance is per Northern Border Tariff Section 6.10.6 - Interruption of Service.

The OFO watch is now in effect through gas day January 2, 2018 to allow the interconnecting parties time to remediate gas quality issues. If the interconnecting party for any of the points listed above is unable to remediate any issue within the given timeframe, Northern Border will, pursuant to Northern Border Tariff Section 5.6 Quality of Gas, issue an OFO requiring immediate shut-in of gas supply into Northern Border at such interconnect.
