Northern Border Pipeline is declaring a Force Majeure event pursuant to Northern Border's FERC Gas Tariff Section 6.9.1 of the General Terms & Conditions. The Reservation Charge Crediting mechanism of Section 6.6.7 shall apply to this outage.

Northern Border Pipeline is experiencing a Force Majeure event at its Glen Ullin Compressor Station (CS #6), located in Morton County, ND due to emergent equipment failure. Effective gas day July 24, 2020, and until further notice. Northern Border Pipeline will restrict nominated volumes for flow past Glen Ullin to 2,365 MDth/D. This is approximately a 4% reduction below the current firm contracted volumes.
