NBPL Emergent Equipment Failure and Notice of Force Majeure

Northern Border Pipeline is declaring a Force Majeure event pursuant to Northern Border's FERC Gas Tariff Section 6.9.1 of the General Terms & Conditions. The Reservation Charge Crediting mechanism of Section 6.6.7 shall apply to this outage.

Northern Border Pipeline is experiencing a Force Majeure event at its Clark Compressor Station 10, located in Clark County, SD, due to emergent compressor station equipment failure, Effective Gas Day 10/30, ID1, and until further notice, Northern Border Pipeline will restrict nominated volumes for Flow Past Glen Ullin (LOC# 43) to 2,382-MDth/D.

Since the last posting this notice has been updated to remove reference to previous CN# 2162.
